Finances: By the numbers

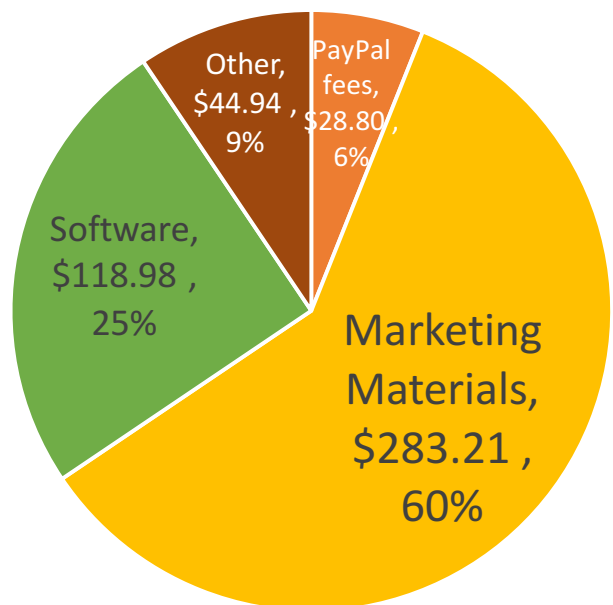
